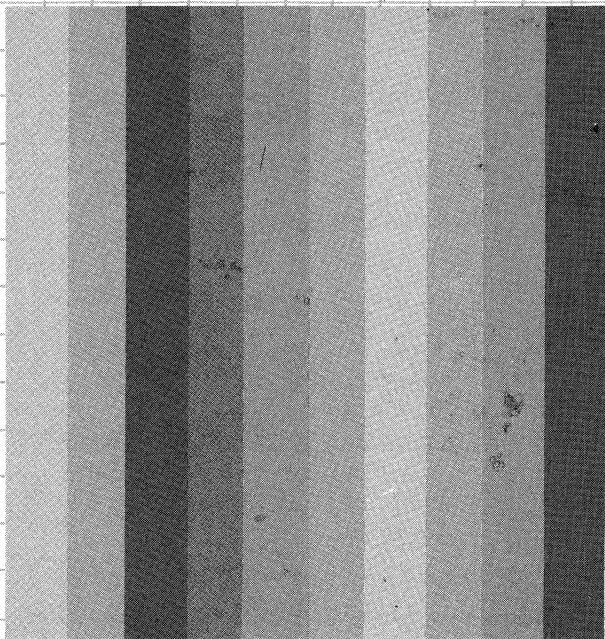

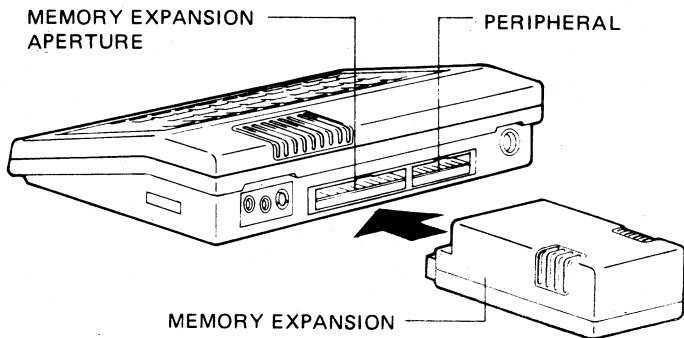

**Instruction Manual**

## MEMORY EXPANSION MODULE

The 16K Memory Expansion Module can provide you plenty of memory space.

### INSTALLATION



**WARNING:** a) TURN OFF THE POWER OF YOUR COMPUTER BEFORE CONNECTING ANY EXPANSION MODULE  
b) KEEP THE SLOT OF THE COMPUTER AND THAT OF THE EXPANSION MODULE CLEAN AND AWAY FROM LIQUIDS

- 1) Turn off the power to your VZ-200 computer.
- 2) Remove the two small phillips-head screws which attach the cover plate marked 'MEMORY EXPANSION' to the rear of the computer case, and discard the plate.
- 3) Plug your 16K memory expansion module into exposed slot, taking care not to use unnecessary force.

- 4) Turn on the power to the computer, and type in the following command.  
Print `peek (30897) + 256* peek (30898)`  
The computer should reply with the number 53247, indicating that the additional memory is operating properly.
- 5) Your VZ-200 is now fitted with a total of 24K of ram memory.
